

P.S. I hope that this paper covers the need of SCOR and ICSU. I did not mention one point which I raised say one year ago, that is the name of SCOR. Should we not take up this problem now and ask for another name, which does not include the word "special"? I made the experience during the last 2 years that the word "special" is combined as CSAGI with the idea of a temporary organisation. It is remarkable that the youngest child of ICSU, that is COSPAR, has not the word "special". Should we suggest instead of SCOR ICOR = International Committee on Oceanic Research?
